

SocialWorkCAS Advisory Committee Purpose and Charge

The SocialWorkCAS Advisory Committee is composed of Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) member programs.

Members will (a) serve as CAS ambassadors to other master's degree social work programs; (b) actively participate in training to help them understand CAS tools, features, and technologies; (c) establish application best practices, tools, and resources to assist programs and students in using the system; (d) make recommendations for enhancing the application for future application cycles; and (e) serve as thought leaders within the admissions and enrollment management industry, informing CSWE of emerging trends and opportunities for enhancement of the CAS.

Subcommittee Structure

To accomplish our goals, the SocialWorkCAS Advisory Committee is divided into the following three subcommittees:

The **Application Process and Improvement Subcommittee** will collect information from CAS participating and nonparticipating members to improve and enhance the application experience and system.

The **Membership and Growth Subcommittee** will focus on program engagement, outreach, and sources of support for education and adoption purposes.

The **Benchmarks**, **Metrics**, **and Data Subcommittee** will identify interests in process and outcomes data collection and will also advise on the most effective approaches for providing and reporting the information gathered.

Time Commitment

SocialWorkCAS Advisory Committee members will commit to a 1-year term, participate in monthly calls, and attend two in-person meetings (all travel expenses covered by CSWE).
